
Freedom from pain

The mother is on treatment.


The sister is back in school.



WHAT IS PALLIATIVE CARE?

Palliative Care is an approach that improves the quality of life of patients and their families facing the problems associated with life-threatening illness, through the prevention and relief of suffering by means of early identification and impeccable assessment and treatment of pain and other physical, psychosocial and spiritual problems. This approach aims to reduce the overall health-related suffering of the patient and the family, improves the quality of life, and death when the time comes, and supports families in bereavement.







Facilities at D1LASA

- Palliative Care, Pain Management, End-of-Life Care
- 25 bedded facility
- Training for newly recruited staff, volunteers, patients and relatives
- Accommodation for duty doctor, nurses and subordinate staff
- Provision for patients' attendants to be around
- Pharmacy for OPD and In-patients
- Palliative Care Physician and Nursing Services

DILASA Expenses & Voluntary Donations

- Out-patient clinic: Registration fees Rs. 100/-
- •Home visit: Registration fees Rs. 100/-

Admissions in General ward: No charges.

Patients in General ward would require to purchase medicines and consumables from the pharmacy at cost price. They can make their own arrangement for food or can get services from our caterer at subsidized rates.

- •Facilities of twin sharing and single occupancy rooms are available with fixed contributions to meet the recurring expenses and maintenance cost.
- Patients admitted in Special rooms would need to purchase the medicines and consumables. Food will be provided by our caterer at no extra cost.

Doctors' and Nurses' services shall be free for all Inmates, Home Visits and at OPD.

- •We welcome voluntary donations from patients receiving palliative care services at OPD, for Home visits and at D1LASA.
- •Donations received shall be utilized towards running of DILASA.
