Indian Medical Association Ponda Branch (IMA) and Dr. Dhaimodker's Occupational Health & Research Centre (DDOHRC) collaboration programs are conducted under the auspices of Dr. Vallabh Dhaimodker Foundation.

The programs are designed to train paramedics, industrial workers, First Responders, social organizations, NGOs and volunteers to get oriented in handling of medical emergencies by learning Basic First Aid, identify health risks, danger to life and understand the procedures of handling casualties during emergency and disaster situations.

The programs have two modules:

- 1. Basic First Aid awareness program.
- 2. Medical Emergencies Preparedness & Disaster Management.

Recommended Basic First Aid Certificate courses forms the foundation for Emergency Medicine. In Disaster situations handling of mass casualties is managed by understanding the concept of Triage.

It is important to know that every Disaster is an emergency but every emergency need not be a disaster. Hence training in disaster management can help in any emergency medical conditions.

The above program modules are designed to train the personnel from all fields at grass root levels to learn the techniques in a simplified way.

Basic First Aid awareness program and Medical Emergencies Preparedness & Disaster Management are designed for eight hours duration each. In due course participants can opt for various training and workshops to upgrade the knowledge.

Trainings are imparted by senior faculty members. Medium of instruction is English. However to simplify the syllabus lectures are also delivered in Hindi, Marathi and Konkani depending upon participants for the course.

Each Batch shall accommodate twenty to twenty four participants.
