First Aid course is of forty hours duration to be covered in ten sessions of four hours each. You are requested to enroll for the course following the sequential manner as under:

- Previous records of First aid (Voucher) certificates, self attested, should be sent along with registration forms

Copy of First Aid Guide and syllabus shall be handed over or sent by speed post or courier to the registered candidates at least two weeks prior to the course, so as to get oriented with First Aid syllabus. In case Guide and syllabus are not collected from our office, shall be sent by speed post or courier at additional cost.

Dates of First aid training programs shall be announced once 30 participants are enrolled for a batch.

- Participants once enrolled shall not be permitted to cancel the registration.
 However Academy shall consider refund of registration fees in genuine circumstances.
 Participants will have to attend the course for total 40 hours. Absenteeism during the course shall not be permitted and will not be allowed to appear for examination.
- → Catering arrangements (morning tea with snacks, lunch, evening tea and mineral water) for participants & faculty shall be done by Academy at the program venue.

- ► Receipts of the payments shall be issued along with course material
- ► Contents of course material

Before the course

- Copy of First Aid Guide and syllabus shall be given 15 days prior to the scheduled program date
- Delegate bag, Folder, writing pad, pen, One Triangular bandage and one roller bandage.

After the course

- Certificate of participation for qualified participants.
- Candidates who don't qualify will have to undergo repeat vigorous training and re-appear for the examination.
